

Scoil Róis Online Code of Conduct

Learning remotely from home has rules just like when we are at school. While we want everyone to enjoy their learning, these rules are there to make sure that pupils and staff are safe and that their privacy is respected while working remotely.

Rules:

1. Pupils must have the permission of a parent/guardian to go online.
2. A parent/guardian must be in the room with a child when they are online. They are ultimately responsible for a child's safety/behaviour online.
3. An appropriate setting should be used for online videos or live work. A pupil must be appropriately dressed before making a recording or going online.
4. Under no circumstances should pre-recorded videos circulated by a staff member be shared without the teacher's knowledge or consent.
5. A pupil may sometimes be invited to take part in a class or group chat. Recording of this chat or class is strictly forbidden. Under no circumstances should a teacher or another child be recorded without their permission.

Scoil Róis will do its utmost to protect the privacy of pupils while learning remotely, we ask that the same respect for privacy be shown to staff members as they teach remotely.
